# GENERAL SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

## 1. SHOW TITLE

**MADE expo - Milano Architettura Design Edilizia** (its 11<sup>th</sup> edition) shall be the subject of the General Show Rules and Regulations stated hereafter; the word "Show" as used herein and hereafter shall mean the Show to be held in the place and on the dates as stated in Art. 3.

## 2. ORGANIZER

The Show is organized by MADE eventi Srl with the support of Fiera Milano S.p.A. MADE eventi Srl has its registered office in Strada Statale del Sempione 28 - 20017 Rho, Milano (Italy) - Operative offices in Bologna, Viale della Mercanzia, 193 - Blocco 1A Galleria B - Funo Centergross, (BO) (Italy), VAT number 05656450961.

## 3. VENUE, DATE AND OPENING HOURS

MADE expo will be held in the Fiera Milano Fairgrounds, Rho from **15 to 18 November 2023**. MADE eventi Srl reserves the right to change the dates of the Show. Opening hours from 9.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m. non-stop. Exhibitors and their staff may enter their exhibition areas at 8.30 a.m. and stay until 6.30 p.m. Only on the first day of the event the Exhibitors are allowed to enter the fairgrounds at 8.00 a.m. MADE eventi Srl may extend the opening hours of the Show for reasons of logistics or public order and for events continuing beyond normal closing hours. The Exhibitor undertakes to respect the opening and closing times of the Show to the public. Therefore, it will not be possible to pack and take goods out of the Show area, close or leave the stand before the closure of the Show.

## 4. ACCESS

The Show is open to duly qualified trade. Authorized visitors may access the Show upon payment of entrance fees. "Exhibitor" passes and vehicle parking passes, in proportion to the occupied exhibition area space (Art. 7.4) will be issued through the Exhibitor Portal managed by Fiera Milano S.p.A.. **Access to the tools of the platform for the issue of "Exhibitor" Cards and vehicle parking tickets is subject to the payment of the settling invoices for participation in the Show.** Exhibitor passes may not be transferred to third parties. In the event of repeated breaches of this clause, MADE eventi Srl may claim compensation for loss of earnings from the infringing Exhibitor also in compliance with art. 34 of the General Rules and Regulations of the Show (hereafter "General Rules and Regulations"). MADE eventi Srl reserves the right to admit the public to the show on specific days as set out in art. 2 of Ministry of Industry circular no. 3275/C of 17.2.1992. **Exhibitors shall not deny visitors access to their exhibition areas.**

## 5. PRODUCT CATEGORIES AND LIMITATIONS

Exhibitors shall display only the products specified on the product list in Attachment 2, which is explicitly approved by signing these General Rules and Regulations, of which it is an integral and substantial part. Exhibitors are prohibited from displaying any products not listed on the Product List.

Exhibitors undertake to respect industrial and intellectual property rights effective in Italy in compliance with Leg. Decree no. 30/2005 and subsequent amendments, as well as the applicable EU and international regulations. The Exhibitors undertake to refrain from exhibiting any product involved in intellectual property litigation resulting in an unfavourable ruling for the Exhibitor. The products for display at the Show must be of the Exhibitor's manufacture and marked as own trademarks or represented thereby; the latter may be entered directly by the Exhibitor on the Exhibitor Portal.

## 6. Exhibitors and Co-Exhibitors

The following may be permitted to exhibit at the Show:

- Italian and international companies displaying their own products or services as per the product list included in Attachment 2. If manufacturers do not participate directly, their sole agents, agents and exclusive sales representatives may do so;
- trade publications and magazines, trade associations, institutions and authorities involved in promoting, researching, publicizing and raising awareness of sectors relating to the themes covered by the Show;
- consortia, temporary groupings or associations of enterprises and/or trade promotion bodies; MADE eventi Srl reserves the right to stipulate participation agreements therewith.

Participation in the Show is in all cases individual and, unless otherwise notified in writing by MADE eventi Srl, all Exhibitors are required to complete and sign the Application Form and submit the required documents. Exhibitors may ask for companies and trademarks that they represent exclusively to be listed in the Catalogue, provided that they are duly registered.

Subject to completion of the Application Form, companies other than the Exhibitor, present with their own products and personnel and with the same characteristics required for the Exhibitor's admission, also defined as "Co-Exhibitor", are admitted to exhibit in the Stand Space assigned to the Exhibitor. These companies are considered Co-Exhibitors even if they have close economic and organizational relations with the stand holder. The acceptance of a Co-Exhibitor must be requested by the stand holder. The stand holder is nonetheless responsible with the Co-Exhibitor for the payment of his share of the co-exhibition fee of € 800,00 + VAT (if due). Hosting a Co-Exhibitor without the Organizer's consent shall authorize the latter to immediately terminate this contract de facto due to the negligence of the Exhibitor and request him to clear out the stand at his own expense

## 7. PARTICIPATION FEES AND ADDITIONAL COSTS

The participation fees, and more specifically the registration fee of € 800,00 + VAT (if due) and the fee for the exhibition area, are indicated in Attachment 1 - Participation fees, Registration deposit and terms of payment. All amounts indicated in Attachment 1 apply to the entire exhibition area along the same perimeter as or adjacent to areas occupied by the same Exhibitor. Exhibitors shall respect the dimensions of their allocated exhibition area. Any additional occupied exhibition space, even for storage, will be charged according to the applicable rates, notwithstanding the obligation to respect the areas the occupation of which may cause interference for safety.

### 7.1 Services included in the participation fee and registration fee:

- general surveillance of the halls and general fire prevention by Fiera Milano S.p.A.;
- heating/air conditioning of the Fairgrounds where the Show will be organized, hereinafter the halls;
- provision of the signage indicating the exhibition area;
- technical assistance to the Exhibitor during the Show and during stand set-up and dismantling operations provided by Fiera Milano S.p.A.;
- Exhibitor passes and free parking passes inside the Fairgrounds according to the conditions specified in Art. 7.4.
- listing in the Pocket Guide and in the on-line Exhibitor list

### Requests for additional car parking spaces (unit cost: € 75.00 + VAT if due) can, in any case, be forwarded to MADE eventi Srl.

If an Exhibitor will occupy more than one exhibiting area not connected by personalized aisles, even if located in the same hall, the Exhibitor shall pay a registration fee for each exhibiting area.

The fee also includes a currently unspecified amount, but higher than 1%, to be allocated to promoting the Show in Italy and abroad. Solely by way of example, this activity may also include the organization of: complementary events staged by MADE eventi Srl or firms or entities appointed by it in Italy and abroad, before, during and after the Show; meetings, conferences, celebrations and social events, including hospitality for members of Italian and international print media, Italian and international trade delegations, Italian and international public authorities, lecturers and conference speakers; study and research activities also in partnership with trade associations; exhibits, also featuring admission fees, in Italy and abroad; events considered to be suitable by the MADE eventi Srl Board of Directors. Such activities will be carried as and when deemed appropriate by the Board of Directors of MADE eventi Srl

### 7.2 Services not included in the participation fee and registration fee:

- **the personalization of the aisles between the exhibition areas assigned and invoiced to the same company is equal to € 45.00 per sq.m + VAT (if due)**; this opportunity is subject to authorization by the Organizer. The personalization of the aisle area will be at the Exhibitor's charge;
- **Exhibitors shall pay the Organizer a lump sum of € 500.00 + VAT (if due) for exceeding the maximum permitted stand fitting height and € 800.00 + VAT (if due) for the affixing of trademarks, logos and graphics in general over 3.50 metres (in this case, the fee of € 800.00 + VAT (if due) also includes the amount due for exceeding the maximum permitted height).**

### 7.3 Lump-sum services

Exhibitors are required to pay MADE eventi Srl a **lump-sum** for compulsory services of **€ 7.50 per sqm + VAT (if due)**. Due to the great increase of the electricity costs, the fee could change; any modification will be communicated to the Exhibitor by 30 September 2023. This fee includes:

- fire extinguishers (rented);
- exhibition area cleaning, i.e. floors and walls, dusting of furniture installed in the exhibition area, emptying of waste paper baskets. The cleaning service does not include cleaning of materials, equipment, furnishings or products on display. Additional specific cleaning services may be officially requested on-line through the Exhibitor Portal on the E-Service card to Fiera Milano S.p.A. Exhibitors may also arrange their own cleaning services, which must be performed between 8.30 and 9.00 a.m. and/or between 6.00 and 6.30 p.m.;
- electricity supply up to 10 kW on every one of the four days of the Show;
- municipal advertising tax: without prejudice to the regulations governing participation, the Exhibitor must pay the Municipality of Rho taxes due pursuant to Presidential Decree no. 639 dated 26.10.1972. This tax is already included in the lump sum. Fiera Milano S.p.A. shall pay the Municipality of Rho on behalf of Exhibitors;
- payment of copyrights deriving from any audio-visual equipment at exhibition area, subject to tax regulations. This coverage, however, does not include live performances with singers and/or musical instruments or for which, if authorized by MADE eventi Srl, the Exhibitor must make direct payment to the SIAE offices in his territory of origin. It also includes all rights, pursuant to art. 72 and 73(b) of Italian Law 633/1941, payable to performers and producers who own the rights to the recordings and, on their behalf, to SCF - Consorzio Fonografici.
- My-Matching portal: a match-making platform that allows Exhibitors and buyers to search for operators and producers of their interest and make appointments before the Show starts; it encourages B2B dialogue and promotes the meeting between supply and demand, guaranteeing concrete business opportunities.

## 7.4 Exhibitor cards

### 7.4.1 Direct Exhibitor

Each Direct Exhibitor is entitled to Exhibitor passes for staff present at the stand and vehicle parking spaces, as follows:

The personal and non-transferable Exhibitor cards are valid on the days of the Show during the Exhibitor hours indicated in Art. 3 of these Regulations. They are also valid for the days of installation and removal during the fitting times indicated in the specific document which will be available on the Exhibitor Portal. Each Co-Exhibitor will receive 3 Exhibitor passes.

### 7.4.2 Represented trademarks

Every company with a represented Italian trademark and company is entitled to no. 2 Exhibitor passes for the staff present at the stand.

### 7.4.3 Paid Exhibitor cards

Exhibitors and brands represented may purchase additional cards to be used exclusively for stand service personnel on the Exhibitor Portal at a cost of **€ 10.00 each + VAT (if due)**. The Exhibitor Card is personal and non-transferable.

## 8. APPLICATION FORM, REGISTRATION FEE, DEPOSITS AND TERMS OF PAYMENT

### 8.1 Registration

The Application Form must be completed, undersigned by the applicant in the case of sole proprietorships, by the legal representative in any other case and sent to MADE eventi Srl - Via di Corticella 89 - 40128

Bologna, Italy and anticipated by mail to [segreteria@madeexpo.it](mailto:segreteria@madeexpo.it). Applications for admission must be received by the Organizer by **31 July 2023**.

The Exhibitor must send the Application Form to the Organizer within the specified time limits and accompanied by:

- Payment of the registration deposit indicated in Attachment 1 - Table 2.1 (payment of the registration fee for the company that owns the exhibition area of **€ 800,00 + VAT (if due)** and of the percentage indicated in Attachment 1 - Table 2.1 calculated on the total participation rate, on the compulsory fee for general exhibition services and on the registration fee for trademarks and Italian represented companies);
- Company Registration certificate or Company Registration Report issued by the Chamber of Commerce no earlier than three months before the date of sending the Application Form;
- VAT exemption declaration

The Organizer has the right to refuse the Exhibitor's admission, at its sole discretion, if the respective Application Form is not accompanied by the expected payment of the deposit payment.

The closing date for registration is **31 July 2023**.

The Organizer reserves the right to accept applications received after the aforementioned deadline or lacking the payment due at its sole discretion. The Organizer will satisfy the requests received in compliance with the laws in force. In any case, Exhibitors who are in any way indebted to MADE eventi Srl or Exhibitors who are in a state that could reasonably be considered to be in danger of bankruptcy or crisis of the Exhibitors themselves will not be admitted to the Show.

## 8.2 Terms of payment

Payment of the "registration deposit", as indicated in Attachment 1 - Table 2.1 shall be made upon forwarding the Application Form.

In any case, the fees outlined in Attachment 1 - Table 1 - participation fees per square metre, will be applied, relating to the crediting of the paid amount on the current account as registration deposit.

**The second instalment of the registration deposit, as per Attachment 1 - Table 2.2, has to be paid as indicated on the Attachment itself.**

In the event of non-payment, MADE eventi Srl shall have the right to terminate all agreements with the company that applied to take part in the Show for default without prior notice or a Court injunction. In this case, besides being free from any commitment and having the right to assign the exhibition area to other applicants, MADE eventi Srl is entitled to a penalty in the amount of the full registration fee and participation fee, plus any other sums due as per the agreement, less any amounts already received for in respect of such fees and without prejudice to the right to claim any greater damages.

## 8.3 Payment of final balance - Exit pass

The participation fee must be paid in full by the date indicated on the relative invoice and in any case by **15 October 2023**, before stand installers enter the Fairgrounds, and/or display products are brought into the venue in the case of standard fitting schemes. All payments are to be made to Fiera Milano S.p.A. Exhibitors who have not paid the balance of the exhibition fee will not be allowed to enter the Fairgrounds. The amounts related to the registration fee and fees shall be paid to Fiera Milano S.p.A. within the established terms and in any case before arrival at the Show area. In the days immediately preceding the closing of the Show, the Administration of Fiera Milano S.p.A. will summarize all invoices issued for additional services and supplies, as well as any other charges still pending that must be settled before the first day of exhibition. Any objections to the charges indicated must be submitted by the end of the Show; after this deadline, they will no longer be accepted. Payments for any additional services requested must be made before the start of the Show. Additional services requested at the Show must be settled at the time of booking. Authorization to leave the Show for the products/goods on display and the fitting material will be issued only to Exhibitors who have settled what due to the Organizer and to Fiera Milano S.p.A..

The statement of account and the invoices will be published on the Exhibitor Portal. The exit of the goods from the Fairgrounds is possible only for those Exhibitors and Fitting companies that show their cards, that will be enabled for such operation only after the settlement of the final balance.

## 8.4 Payment terms

The name of the Show and the name of the Exhibitor must be indicated in the reason for payment.

## 8.5 VAT laws

As from 1 January 2011, according to Legislative Decree no. 18/2010, implementing EU Directive no. 8/2008, taxable international Exhibitors are no longer required to pay VAT (if due) on the participation fee and services related to the Show, except for non-taxable persons (e.g. private individuals); to identify the type of the ordering party (taxable/non-taxable), it is essential to receive information on the VAT number/

identification code or other appropriate documentation proving the status as company and not as private individual before issuing the invoice. It is therefore absolutely necessary that the Applications for Participation are received with the above information; otherwise, invoices shall be issued with Italian VAT.

All activities relating to "Access and related activities" and "Food service, Catering, Tasting and Hotel Services" remain subject to VAT.

## 8.6 Electronic invoicing between private individuals

To comply with the obligations introduced by art. 1, par. 909, Act 27 December 2017 (obligation from 1/1/2019 to issue electronic invoices between individuals), the Italian Exhibitor will inform the Organizer of its certified e-mail address (CEM) and/or its seven-digit recipient code.

## 8.7 Cash flow traceability

MADE eventi Srl, in carrying out the services provided for in these Rules and Regulations, ensures compliance with all the obligations of cash flow traceability pursuant to art. 3 of Law no. 136 of 13 August 2010, as amended and supplemented, in particular **if the Exhibitor is a public authority and/or a company with public capital and/or in any case considered a "contracting authority" within the meaning of the aforesaid law**, under penalty of nullity of the contractual relationship. The Exhibitor who is considered a "contracting authority" within the meaning of the aforesaid law shall fill in the Application Form containing, under penalty of nullity of the Application Form, the mandatory CIG code (CODICE IDENTIFICATIVO DI GARA - TENDER IDENTIFICATION CODE) and - where necessary - the CUP code (CODICE UNICO DI PROGETTO - PROJECT UNIQUE CODE) pertaining to the applicable public investment.

## 9. ACCEPTANCE OF THE GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

By forwarding the Application Form duly signed to indicate acceptance, the Exhibitor and Co-Exhibitor undertakes to participate in the Show in the allocated exhibition area even if the exhibition area is of a different size or in a different position to that requested and to accept without reservation these Regulations and all additional regulations that will be issued at any time by the Organizer in the interest of the Show, As well as the Technical Regulations of the Fiera Milano Fairgrounds available on the Fiera Milano website.

The stand size and type requested on the Application Form shall not be binding upon MADE eventi Srl, which may allocate a stand of different size and type if the request is - at the sole discretion of MADE eventi Srl - incompatible with overall organization requirements or organizational requirements in connection with exhibition areas dedicated to specific product categories.

Exhibitors shall be entitled to use the stand as specified in the official notification of stand allocation as set out in art. 11 below. In any case, occupation of a specific exhibition area or type by an Exhibitor during earlier editions of the Show does not give the Exhibitor priority in the allocation of the same exhibition area or type in subsequent editions of the Show. The Exhibitor and the Co-Exhibitor declare that they have examined and understood the Code of Ethics of the Fiera Milano Group, the latest version of which is published on the website [www.madeexpo.it](http://www.madeexpo.it) and undertake not to commit any violation of the principles set out therein. The Exhibitor and the Co-Exhibitor also declare that they are aware of the contents of the Legislative Decree 231/2001 undertaking to refrain from conducts suitable for configuring the offenses referred to in the decree itself. **The Exhibitor and the Co-Exhibitor undertake to fully accept every part of the General Regulations insofar as, for all legal purposes, they make up the agreement to participate in the Show.**

## 10. ADMITTANCE

MADE eventi Srl shall inform the Exhibitors that their application has been accepted by notifying their allocated exhibition area.

Participation in one or earlier editions of the Show does not automatically grant the right to participate in subsequent editions (see art. 7). Exhibitors who fail to pay all amounts due in full may be denied participation in future events of the Show by MADE eventi Srl. The application may be rejected or cancelled by MADE eventi Srl if, in addition to the cases of non-eligibility set out in art. 8 above, it results that:

- a) the Exhibitor breached the General Rules and Regulations during a previous Show and was therefore excluded from it;
- b) the Exhibitor proved to be insolvent or bankrupt;
- c) the Exhibitor failed to pay all the amounts still due for participating in a previous edition of the Show.

Moreover, MADE eventi Srl reserves the right to deny admittance to the Show if it believes, at its sole discretion, that the applicant does not conform to the requirements. Accordingly, MADE eventi Srl may have its staff visit companies to assess their eligibility and characteristics; the applicants shall consent to such visits by signing the Application Form.

## 11. EXHIBITION AREA ALLOCATION

The exhibition areas shall be allocated within the limits of the venue and to ensure the success of the Show. MADE eventi Srl has sole discretion over the allocation of exhibition areas. Recommendations or special requests made by the Exhibitor shall constitute mere suggestions and are not binding upon the application; they shall not affect the application and as such shall not be entertained. If the Exhibitor's or Co-Exhibitor's production does not correspond to the product category that the Exhibitor and Co-Exhibitor have requested to be assigned to, MADE eventi Srl has

the right to change its allocation to a more suitable area, according to the rules outlined in this article, within the exhibition as MADE eventi Srl will deem adequate. If needed, MADE eventi Srl has the right to modify or move or reduce the size of pre-allocated exhibition areas, i.e. to assign the exhibition area to a different zone without entitling the Exhibitor to reimbursement or compensation of any kind. MADE eventi Srl has the right to do this at any time and even after having notified the exhibition area allocation. In any case, the Exhibitor shall receive written notification at least 15 days before the Show commences. MADE eventi Srl has the right to allocate exhibition areas even to different zones from the ones used for exhibiting purposes that may not appear on the floor plan. Exhibitors who have submitted a regular Application Form within the registration deadline set out in art. 8 of these General Rules and Regulations, may download from the Exhibitor Portal the exhibition area allocation notification together with the 1:100 scale floor plan and information regarding the technical, executive and safety provisions necessary for outfitting.

## 12. WITHDRAWAL AND CANCELLATION OF THE EVENT

Companies that sent Application Forms by the deadline indicated in art. 8 of the General Rules and Regulations, or if accepted by MADE eventi Srl after this deadline, and which cannot participate in the Show may withdraw from the agreement notifying MADE eventi Srl by registered mail with return receipt or CEM by 15 June 2023. If the withdrawal communication will be sent within the aforesaid deadline, the Exhibitor will be requested to pay the registration fee and 50% of the participation costs per sqm multiplied per the sqm requested of exhibiting area. If the cancellation is notified after the aforesaid deadline or it is not communicated at all, the company shall pay, **by way of penalty**, in addition to the registration fee, the entire participation fee (the sum of the registration fee, participation fee per sqm multiplied by the requested area and a flat service fee per sqm for the area requested), without prejudice to MADE eventi Srl's right to seek compensation for any other direct and/or indirect damages.

MADE eventi Srl for reasons connected with the organization and running of the Show may withdraw from the contract at its discretion until 10 days before the opening of the Show. In this case, MADE eventi Srl shall be under no obligation to reimburse the Exhibitor.

## 13. SUBLETTING

The allocation is valid only for the Exhibitor to whom it is addressed. The Exhibitor shall not assign, sublet or transfer in any manner the whole or any part of the allocated area, not even free of charge. Breaching this rule shall result in the right to immediately close down stands and charge all incurred expenses to the official Exhibitor, as well as to exclude both the sub-lessor and the sub-lessee from future Shows.

## 14. EXECUTIVE TECHNICAL PROVISIONS AND SAFETY IN THE WORKPLACE

In addition to the planimetric survey of the respective exhibition areas assigned or reassigned, the Organizer shall make available to the Exhibitors the Technical Regulations issued by Fiera Milano S.p.A. in their current version (hereinafter the "Technical Regulations") and will communicate to the Exhibitor any additional technical or general updates that may be established by the Organizer itself and/or by Fiera Milano S.p.A.: in relation to the best organization and functioning of the Exhibition and/or the Trade Show Centre through additions to the General Regulations, hereafter "additions to the General Regulations" or "executive technical provisions".

Each Exhibitor is required to scrupulously comply with the entire regulatory system in force, also and above all with regard to the protection of the health and physical integrity of workers, and with labour, social security and welfare legislation for the entire duration of the Exhibition, including the time required for the assembly and dismantling of stands and any other related activity, waste disposal included.

Furthermore, the Exhibitor undertakes to observe and ensure that all contractors working on its behalf, during the assembly and dismantling of the stand and in relation to any other related or connected activity, comply with the Technical Regulations of Fiera Milano S.p.A. and any supplementary sections thereof that he declares having fully understood, the provisions contained in art. 88 of the Italian Legislative Decree 81/2008, paragraph 2-bis and its implementing Ministerial Decree of 22.7.2014, issued by the Ministry of Labour and Social Policies and the Ministry of Health.

The Technical Regulations, which can be consulted on the website [www.fieramilano.it](http://www.fieramilano.it), in the section "Exhibitors - Technical Documents - Link to event" contain, among other things, precautionary rules regarding exhibition safety (fire prevention, electrical systems, environmental protection, etc.), with the exclusion of the specific safety rules concerning the activities carried out by the Exhibitor or contracted out by the latter to the contractors (stand assembly and dismantling and related activities), the verification and observance of which remains the responsibility of the Exhibitor itself.

For the purposes of fulfilling the obligations contained in the Italian Ministerial Decree 22.7.2014 above, the Organizer makes the documents referred to in Annexes IV and V of the Ministerial Decree itself available on its own website and that of Fiera Milano S.p.A..

Behaviors that do not comply with the above safety regulations, in particular when they may affect the general safety of the halls and

third parties present, may be subject to intervention by the Organizer and/or Fiera Milano S.p.A., in the context of sample checks and lead to the immediate closure of the stand until safety conditions are restored. Any other consequence that may arise from non-compliance with the aforementioned provisions is solely attributable to the responsibility of the Exhibitor and the companies appointed by him.

Fiera Milano S.p.A. may remove from the Exhibition Centre the personnel of the executing companies/self-employed workers who work on behalf of the Exhibitor from the Fiera exhibition center if they do not have the identification card provided for in Articles 18, c. 1, lett. u); 21, c. 1, lett. c); 26, c. 8 of the Legislative Decree 81/08 and non-EU personnel if, even in the presence of the aforementioned card, they are not in possession of a residence permit and/or a legible and valid identity card.

The Employer who is responsible for such personnel will be charged consequently. The Exhibitor that, as customer, has authorized the company to operate in the district on its own account for the execution of works, will be informed of the claim.

The Exhibitor is responsible for the compliance with the regulations in force of everything that is carried out and organized on its behalf in relation to outfittings, structures, systems, products on display and all related activities.

Each Exhibitor must appoint a "Contact Person for the Exhibition Safety of the Exhibitor" (hereinafter RSE) who will, for safety purposes, be liable towards all subjects possibly involved for all responsibilities in respect of the activities conducted on the Exhibitor's behalf during the entire time of stay at the exhibition district. At the Exhibitor's discretion, and under its full responsibility, the RSE may also be a different person in each of the three stages mentioned above (assembly, exhibition and dismantling).

The name of the RSE and all references (email, telephone, etc.) must be communicated to the Organizer (and through the latter to Fiera Milano S.p.A.), before the start of the assembly work of the stand and in any case before access by workers and the introduction of materials in the exhibition center. At the Organizer, the names and references of the RSE of neighboring stands will be made available to Exhibitors. Each Exhibitor, through his/her own RSE, is obliged to coordinate with the other RSE of the adjacent stands, so that, through the exchange of information, any prevention measures to be identified can be identified, apply to eliminate or, where this is not possible, minimize the risks from interference, when present. In the absence of communication of the name of the RSE, this function will remain the responsibility of the Legal Representative of the Exhibitor. Any changes must be promptly communicated to the Organizer. The most relevant obligation for the Customer [Exhibitor] concerns the DUVRI [unified document for the assessment of interference risks], or the PSC [safety and coordination plan] in the event that, respectively, the rules contained in article 26 of the Italian Legislative Decree 81/08 are applied, or those contained in Title IV of the same decree, according to the provisions of the Italian Interministerial Decree of 22 July 2014. This documentation must be uploaded to the appropriate section of the Fiera Milano Exhibitor platform, that we remind you to be available to the competent authorities (ATS and law enforcement agencies), and be present at the stand for the entire period of the event (including assembly and dismantling).

## 15. EXHIBITION AREA FITTING AND CUSTOMIZATION

The Exhibitor is responsible for fitting the exhibition areas, including decoration and furnishing, at their own expense; **partial or no partition and/or bordering walls are not allowed as well as fitting without lighting systems.**

The stand must be fitted within the area assigned to the Exhibitor, which can be identified using adhesive tapes or coloured strips on the floor, remaining within the allocated area; any occupancy of areas other than those assigned, without prejudice to the Organizer's right to prevent this, will be due by the Exhibitor at the price per square metre specified in the Application Form. The exhibition areas must be completed by 6.00 p.m. on **14 November 2023**. After this deadline, MADE eventi Srl may otherwise dispose of the unoccupied exhibition areas, deeming the exhibiting company's willingness to participate in the Show to have lapsed and applied to it the economic conditions provided for in art. 12 of these General Rules and Regulations, without prejudice to the obligation to pay any further expenses incurred by MADE eventi Srl for the closure of the stand and/or possible reuse thereof. The mobilization and demobilization times shall be communicated by Fiera Milano S.p.A. with a special circular available on [www.fieramilano.it/en](http://www.fieramilano.it/en) - calendar - Exhibitors technical information or through the Exhibitor Portal.

### 15.1 Characteristics

**The fittings must have characteristics of decorum and furnishing complying with the quality standard of the Show. The Organizer, therefore, reserves the right to demand adjustments, if it does not consider it respected. The fittings and the respective systems must be built in a workmanlike manner, in compliance with accident prevention and fire prevention regulations. The Organizer reserves the right to have the fittings and installations modified or renewed if they do not comply with the provisions and prescriptions indicated above.**

### 15.2 Fitting designs

**All Exhibitors with empty areas are required to upload on the Exhibitor Portal, in the dedicated card "Activate fitting company and upload stand fitting design" a complete fitting design with**

**dimensions and heights for testing and checking. The fitting works cannot be started unless the fitting design is submitted.**

The fitting design, complete with plans indicating the orientation, listed sections, renderings and precise indications of the areas in which graphics will be applied, shall be attached in the appropriate section on the Exhibitor Portal, within and no later than 30 days from the notification of allocation of the exhibition area and in any case no later than 15 days before the start of the Show.

Fiera Milano "Customer Service - Exhibitors Assistance" will review the fitting design for conformity with the Show and Technical Regulations and approve it or demand adjustments as necessary.

### 15.3 Arrangements for fitting

The provisions of these Regulations must be strictly observed and adhered to when fitting the exhibition area. In particular, the following provisions shall be implemented:

- **Wall height: the maximum height allowed for the stands is 3.50 metres**, including the thickness of raised floors, lighting elements and related supports. MADE eventi Srl allows exhibiting companies to request a waiver from the maximum height rule indicated above and build structures up to a maximum of 6 meters.

**The Exhibitor shall pay the Organizer for such excess:**

- **a lump sum equal to of € 500.00 + VAT (if due) for exceeding the maximum permitted height;**
  - **a sum of € 800.00 + VAT (if due) for the affixing of trademarks, logos and graphics in general at a height over 3.50 metres. (the fee of € 800.00 + VAT (if due) also includes the amount due for exceeding the maximum permitted height).**
- Excess height consisting exclusively of fittings with lighting fixtures and/or of exhibiting products (if these will not show any logo, banners or advertising images) shall be excluded from the above fees.** Neighbouring walls must have a neutral finish, in white and made "in a workmanlike manner" and must not have any writing, logos, trademarks, images or graphics.

- **Architectural elements:** structures (masts, trellises, flagpoles, banner poles, totems, etc.) may be authorized for a height of 6.5 metres upon presentation of the project as indicated above, and if compatible with the structural constraints of the hall. These structures must be arranged in such a way that they do not cut off visibility and light, or cause annoyance or in any case damage to other adjacent Exhibitors. In creating stand perimeter walls, the Exhibitor must respect the following requirements: perimeter walls longer than 6 meters must provide continuity solutions at full height (openings/passages for entry/exit from the stand, french doors, windows, glass walls, etc.) with a frequency of at least one opening every 6 linear meters and for 50% of the total length. These requirements are aimed at respecting the exhibition visibility of the adjacent stands: projects that do not comply with these clauses cannot be approved and must be modified. This clause also applies to the upper part of the raised platforms/mezzanines. Therefore, no continuous structures may be built inside the exhibition area that prevent the visibility of the surrounding Exhibitors.

- No changes may be made to the fixed structures of the halls (walls, columns, floors); painting, varnishing, application of nails and hooks, glueing and similar operations are also forbidden.
- No changes may be made to the technical installations (electrical, water, telephone, fire-extinguishing systems), which must be left accessible at all times; fire-extinguishing equipment and systems must be left visible and accessible from any point.
- Suspended structures: the construction of suspended structures is allowed in compliance with the height limits described above.

- **Ramps and platforms for wheelchair access:** each exhibition area with a platform must be accessible with at least one ramp. Steps or ramps must not obstruct the paths of the public in the aisle; the corners of the platform must be rounded or protected and the perimeter must be closed with the possibility of inspection on each side. The corners of the platforms at aisle crossings must be protected to prevent visitors from tripping.

- **Raised platforms/mezzanines:** raised platforms can be built inside the stand in accordance with the construction standards and conditions specifically indicated in the "Rules for the assembly of raised platforms in the show areas of the Fiera Milano (Rho) Fairgrounds" booklet prepared by Fiera Milano S.p.A.. Subject to authorization and submission of the detailed design, these multi-storey structures must be located in the centre of the stand or on one of the sides provided that the latter faces the hall perimeter walls. The maximum height is 5 metres from the ground. The raised platform areas, excluding access stairs, must not exceed 50% of the total exhibition area or cover more than 200 square metres regardless of the size of the exhibition area.

The raised platform areas will be charged in accordance with the fees shown in Attachment 1 - Table 1 - participation fees per square metre.

- **Structures in the aisle between stands of the same Exhibitor:** exhibition structures resting on the ground must be approved by Fiera Milano S.p.A. and provided with the necessary certifications. The space occupied in the aisle will be charged according to the fee

indicated in art. 7.2. Thin flooring may be laid in the portion of the aisle facing the stands of the same Exhibitor provided that the following conditions are met:

- the availability of the Exhibitor's personnel must be guaranteed at all times, including on public holidays, for the necessary assistance (stringing, securing, etc.);
- Fiera Milano S.p.A. has the right to intervene on the flooring whenever deemed necessary, including removal, with costs to be borne by the Exhibitor, who will in any case hold Fiera Milano S.p.A. harmless from any liability in relation to possible deterioration or damage, total or partial, of the carpet itself;
- installation must in no case cause delays or jeopardize the proper performance of services for which Fiera Milano S.p.A. is responsible, including cleaning, either during the mobilization or demobilization of the Show;
- **the installation must be carried out in the hours immediately before the deadline for mobilization operations;**
- the removal must be carried out immediately after the closure of the Show or, in any case, within the first hours allowed for the dismantling of the fittings;
- Fiera Milano S.p.A. reserves the right to assess on a case-by-case basis and, if necessary, deny the laying of the flooring if it may cause damage or annoyance to other Exhibitors.

### 15.4 Certifications of structures/fittings/systems

All structures/fittings/systems made in the Show area must be certified for the observance of legal regulations. The documentation shall be delivered to Fiera Milano S.p.A.. In particular, the mandatory certifications to be delivered are:

- a) the declaration of conformity and correct installation of the fitting materials must be submitted for fire prevention purposes. The use of the fitting materials is permitted only on the condition that they are accompanied by a regular document certifying their reaction to fire class under Ministerial Decree 26/06/1984. From the Exhibitor Portal, the Exhibitor must download the "Fitting material fire safety" form. The filled-in form must be delivered to Fiera Milano S.p.A. at the end of the work;
- b) declaration in conformity to Ministerial Decree 37/08 shall be submitted for additional electrical systems; Exhibitors who use the services of foreign electrical equipment fitters, as usual, in place of the Declaration of Conformity under Ministerial Decree 37/08, must request a compliance check from Fiera Milano S.p.A. on the Exhibitor Portal;
- c) a declaration of correct installation of the fittings must be produced. From the specific section "Mandatory documents" on the Exhibitor Portal, the Exhibitor must download the "Correct assembly declaration" form. The filled-in form must be kept at the stand at the end of the work.

## 16. PRESENTATION OF PRE-FABRICATED STRUCTURES, CRANES, SCAFFOLDINGS, ETC. AND RULES FOR DISPLAYING WORKING MACHINERY

To display pre-fabricated structures, tower cranes, self-elevating cranes and the like, or scaffolding of any kind, Exhibitors shall ensure the complete and meticulous application of all safety rules, legal provisions, regulations and rules of good practice dictated by experience and prudence for the entire time of permanence in the Fairgrounds, and undertake to comply with all instructions issued by Fiera Milano S.p.A. and MADE eventi Srl, as summarized on the specific document sent on-demand as an electronic document. The installation and operation of the above-mentioned machines and equipment are subject to the written approval by Fiera Milano S.p.A. and MADE eventi Srl.

## 17. ENTRANCE, TRANSIT AND PARKING INSIDE THE SHOW AREA DURING ASSEMBLY AND DISMANTLING PHASES

The dates of assembly and dismantling are governed by the document "Assembly and dismantling rules" available on the Exhibitor Portal.

### 17.1 Rules for access and pedestrian traffic

To access and circulate in the exhibition area, the Exhibitors and/or the Personnel of the subjects operating on their behalf shall have a special personal access card. To request access cards during assembly and dismantling, each Exhibitor shall enter the necessary data on the Exhibitor Portal. The "Assembly and dismantling rules" indicating the days and times allowed for entry are indicated in the same area. After entering the data, the Exhibitor will receive valid access passes by e-mail. **Exhibitor cards (see art. 7.4) are also valid on the days of mobilization and dismantling.**

For the access of its Fitters/Contractors, the Exhibitor will proceed to the authorization using the pre-accreditation system on the Exhibitor Portal. All personnel of companies working on behalf of the Exhibitor shall also display the identification card provided for in art. 18, paragraph 1, letter u, art. 21, paragraph 1, letter c), art. 26, paragraph 8 of Legislative Decree no. 81/08.

Please note that staff not in good standing with access permission and without the required documents will be immediately removed from the exhibition area.

**IMPORTANT! Access to non-operators and minors under the age of 15 is forbidden in the exhibition areas while maintenance and/or assembly/dismantling work is in progress.**

For minors between the ages of 15 and 18 years of age, access to the

exhibition area for work purposes is permitted only on the condition that the laws in force regarding the employment of children, with particular reference to Law no. 977/1967 on the protection of children and adolescents, are complied with.

### 17.2 Rules for access and movement of vehicles

To request pre-accreditation for vehicles during assembly and dismantling, the Exhibitor shall enter the necessary data on the Exhibitor Portal. The "Assembly and dismantling rules" and the plan of the Fairgrounds with the access points can be found in the same area. After entering the data, the Exhibitor has to download from the Exhibitor Portal a barcode which must be shown to the staff present at the entrances. For the access of its Fitters/Contractors, the Exhibitor will proceed to the authorization using the Logistics pre-accreditation system. The barcode must be clearly displayed on the windshield of the vehicle for circulation and parking, allowed only for loading/unloading operations. Barcodes are not transferable, in case of abuse the Logistics Service of Fiera Milano S.p.A. will collect them. Vehicles without an identification barcode can be registered by contacting the Offices of the Show. Please note that vehicular and pedestrian traffic in the exhibition area is governed by the rules of the Highway Code. In particular, attention is drawn to strict compliance with the horizontal and vertical signs and the speed limit of 20 km/hour prescribed in the area of the Show. Driving at walking space may be required under special conditions. In compliance with what has just been said, however, the speed of the vehicles must always be suited to the state of the existing places and situations. It is absolutely forbidden to park vehicles in front of driveways, fire hydrants, emergency exits, near crossroads and in areas in front of public utilities (First Aid, Fire Service, etc.). Due to the high density of traffic in the exhibition area during assembly and dismantling, all drivers shall:

- strictly adhere to the routes and parking areas indicated by the service staff in charge of supervision and traffic of the Organizer;
- limit parking for loading and unloading to no more than 2 hours;
- not leave vehicles parked overnight (not even in case of breakdown) inside the exhibition area, from 8:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m., and, in any case, in case of extended opening hours, not later than the closing time.

### 17.3 Measures for the protection of the safety of persons present in the exhibition area

Fiera Milano S.p.A., in observance of the obligations imposed by the Public Safety Authorities, adopts the infrastructure, organizational and operative measures it deems appropriate to protect the safety of persons present for any reason in the Show Area. As a non-exhaustive example, at its sole discretion, Fiera Milano S.p.A. may provide:

- particular ways of accessing and exiting the Show Area (destination of specific reserved gates or aisles, timetables, access and flow control systems) - even differentiated - for the different categories of users of the Area;
- security checks, also carried out with the aid of fixed or portable technical equipment and instruments, on persons, luggage and personal effects, and on means of transport and work, both at the time of entering the Show Area and inside it and, where necessary, at the time of leaving it. The checks will be run by Fiera Milano S.p.A. staff or third parties charged by the former to do so. Without prejudice to the reporting of the fact to the Police and any measures taken by the same, users who do not submit to said controls will be denied access to the Show Area and, should they already be in the Show Area, will be removed immediately therefrom. Users subjected to checks must collaborate fully, to ensure that the checks are completed as effectively and quickly as possible, given the nature of the activity. On conclusion of said checks, without prejudice to the reporting of the fact to the Police and any measures taken by the same, Fiera Milano S.p.A. reserves the inalienable right to deny access to the Area to any suspicious persons or objects, and should the suspicious persons already be in the Area, to immediately remove them, while suspicious objects must be removed immediately from the Area by and under the responsibility of their custodians. Fiera Milano S.p.A. is not required to provide any custodial service for suspicious objects;
- variations or restrictions on the circulation of pedestrian and vehicular traffic inside the Exhibition Area, including the use of fencing, Jersey barriers, speed limiters and similar equipment;
- forcible removal, at the risk and expense of the owner, of means of transport or work, objects or personal effects considered suspect or otherwise hindering the exercise of security controls. The provisions in the paragraph above also apply to all visitors and guests admitted to the Show.

### 18. ECOLOGICAL SERVICES, WASTE DISPOSAL, EMPTY PACKAGING/PACKING CASE SERVICE

The collection, storage, transportation and recycling of waste must be carried out in compliance with Legislative Decree n. 152 of 2006 and subsequent amendments and additions.

The Exhibitor is obliged to remove waste materials and rubbish from the event area daily, disposing of them in authorized reclamation/disposal plants, in accordance with current legislation.

Under the Technical Regulations the Exhibitor and his appointees are jointly and severally liable for the correct management of waste produced within the assigned exhibition space. It is forbidden for the Exhibitor (or any appointees) to abandon waste of any kind within the

exhibition spaces, both in the assigned space and in the common areas (lanes, access roads, etc.). The Exhibitor and/or his appointees shall remove the waste produced directly or use the professionals authorized for the management of waste and enrolled in the National Register of Environmental Managers, which can be consulted at: <https://www.albonazionalegestoriambientali.it/public/elenchiiscritti>.

**The prohibition of waste abandonment and the connected obligation for the correct management of the same must be applied to all waste materials and those resulting from the assembly/disassembly procedures (packaging, materials used as walls, false ceilings, floor coverings, etc.).**

The waste materials deriving from the cleaning of the stand during the event are excluded and will be attended to by the companies appointed by Fiera Milano S.p.A., which concern the cleaning of the floor, the cleaning of any coatings and emptying of the waste paper baskets and bins of the stand. **In the event of waste abandonment in the pavilions or within the fairground, Fiera Milano S.p.A. will apply a penalty of € 5,000.00 without prejudice to compensate for the greater damage, also reserving the right to remove the personnel responsible from the locality and undertake legal proceedings.** The Exhibitor is required to comply with all local regulations in force and in accordance with the Regulations governing solid urban waste collection services, differentiated collection and urban hygiene, currently in force and applied by the Rho Municipal Council pursuant to Art. 198, C.3 of Legislative Decree 152/2006. During the course of the event, the Exhibitor and his appointees are required to separate the waste produced according to type and nature in containers located within the pavilions and in the specially equipped outdoor areas. In this way, the precise management of the different types of waste can be guaranteed along with its reclamation and disposal in controlled environments.

The official shippers are available for the collection, storage and return of the empty packaging at the end of the event according to the rates in force and present on the Exhibitor Portal; the reference numbers can be found on the Exhibitor Portal - E-Service tool as "Other Services".

### 19. CATERING SERVICE

Fiera Milano S.p.A. offers catering services through the Exhibitor Portal in the dedicated section and/or by contacting [ristorazione@fieramilano.it](mailto:ristorazione@fieramilano.it) - tel +39 02. 4997.6365/7805.

For catering companies external to the Fiera Milano Group and for Exhibitors who autonomously administer drinks and foodstuffs access and the supplying of new stocks is permitted through payment of the relative access passes together with presentation of the related documentation.

The procedure can be viewed on the Exhibitor Portal in the mandatory documents section and the Fiera Milano Technical Regulations section. With the acceptance of these General Regulations for the event, the owners of stands which are autonomously active in the provision of catering services not organised directly by Fiera Milano S.p.A., declare that they are aware of the content of DPCM of 17th May 2020 and subsequent amendments and additions and will respect the relevant regulations.

### 20. HAND-OVER AND HAND-BACK OF EXHIBITION AREAS

When occupying the exhibition area for the fitting and arrangement of goods, the Exhibitor is required to notify CUSTOMER SERVICE (Exhibitor Assistance) of any discrepancies concerning the floor plan stated in the stand allocation. At the end of the Show, the exhibition area must be returned to its pristine state, having it checked by CUSTOMER SERVICE (Exhibitor Assistance); any damage caused by Exhibitors will be charged to them at the cost requested by Fiera Milano S.p.A. In the case of standardized fittings offered by MADE eventi Srl, the removal of products and materials from the stand must take place within the times specifically indicated by the fitting supplier; the stands must be returned in the conditions in which they were taken over. Exhibitors are liable for any repair costs and are also responsible for observing the special regulations for the use of the structures and technical systems.

### 21. GENERAL SURVEILLANCE, FIRE PREVENTION AND STAND CLEANING

**21.1 The overall surveillance of the exhibition halls** shall be provided by Fiera Milano S.p.A. which shall also adopt fire prevention measures.

The Fiera Milano Technical Regulations contains the instructions that Exhibitors must follow to avoid the risk of fire. Surveillance and custody responsibility for exhibiting areas and exhibits is at the exclusive charge of the respective Exhibitors for the entire opening time of the halls, during the show and during the assembly and dismantling times.

**21.2 The stand cleaning service** will be provided after the closure of the halls by Fiera Milano S.p.A.. The service comprises the cleaning of the floor and any coverings (e.g. carpeting, excluding washing and the removal of stains or traces of stains), the dusting of furniture (excluding exposed furniture) installed in the stand and the emptying of waste bins.

### 22. ADVERTISING MATERIAL

MADE eventi Srl promotes the Show using various advertising materials, before, during and after the Show.

The data of each Exhibitor and Co-Exhibitor listed in the Pocket Guide, in

the online catalogue and in the lists that may be made available online and offline are those indicated in the Application Form relating to the data of each Exhibitor.

Late applications to exhibit at the Show, even if accepted, may not be included in the Catalogue.

MADE eventi Srl declines all responsibility for any omissions, wrong indications and/or descriptions and printing errors relating to the Exhibitor's data.

### 23. OPTIONAL SERVICES

Optional services (catering, internet connections, hanging structures, technical services, spotlight rental, etc.) may be requested on-line by Exhibitors on the Exhibitor Portal in the E-Service card. Exhibitors shall use the FIERAID access codes received from Fiera Milano S.p.A.

**Evening Party service:** This service allows Exhibitors to stay in their exhibition area after the closing time of the Show to offer an occasion of relaxation and entertainment for their customers who are already inside the Fairgrounds. To the services included (dedicated security, air conditioning in the exhibition area, electricity at the stand, cleaning of the aisles adjacent to the stand at the end of the event, activation and supervision of toilets near the stand, opening of an outgoing Cargo Door) it is possible to add services such as: catering, promoters, audio/video systems, setting/fitting, floral decorations, photos, extra cleaning of the stand at the end of the event, etc.) that can be ordered on the Exhibitor Portal at the E-Service card.

The Customer Service (e-mail [made@customerservice.fieramilano.it](mailto:made@customerservice.fieramilano.it)) is available for information and personalized quotations. The provision of the service is subject to the approval of MADE eventi Srl.

### 24. INSURANCE - LIABILITY LIMITATIONS

#### 24.1 "All Risks" - Policy for Exhibitors (excluding Terrorism and Sabotage)

The Exhibitor must have an "All Risks" Policy covering the total value of all goods, machinery, equipment and fittings brought and/or used in the Exhibition Centre with a clause for waiver of compensation from the Fiera Milano Foundation, Fiera Milano S.p.A., the subsidiaries and associates, the Organizer and third parties in any case interested in the organization of the Exhibition. In the event of a claim by its Insurer, the Exhibitor guarantees to hold the aforementioned Subjects harmless.

Fiera Milano S.p.A. provides the Exhibitor, without any burden or cost for the latter of an "All Risks" policy covering goods, machinery, equipment and installations brought in and/or used in the exhibition centre, for an amount of €25,000.00

The coverage includes a 10% excess for each claim in the event of theft, with a minimum of € 250.00 and with the doubling of these amounts for reports submitted after the closure of the event. Reports of damage and/or theft must be strictly submitted within 24 hours to the Customer Service office and to the Police authorities within 72 hours.

In the Exhibitor Portal "Document management - Insurance section" there is a link which will give more information on the "All Risks" insurance coverage, provided free by Fiera Milano S.p.A..

**24.2 Civil liability policy towards third parties** - Fiera Milano S.p.A. will automatically provide this insurance for all Exhibitors, including them in its own general policy and without any charge being made to them. The policy includes a ceiling of not less than €100,000,000.00 (One hundred million Euros).

**24.3 Limitations of responsibility** - The Exhibitor agrees to release Fiera Milano S.p.A. and the Organizer from any liability for consequential damages, image damage, loss of turnover, etc.

In terms of direct damages, given that each Exhibitor is the custodian of the reserved exhibition spaces and responsible for the goods contained therein, the Exhibitor assumes all responsibility and expressly exonerates Fiera Milano S.p.A. and the Organizer from any liability with regard to goods and/or values covered and/or not covered and/or in excess of what has been stated in Art. 1 above.

The Exhibitor acknowledges and accepts that Fiera Milano S.p.A. will not provide insurance benefits/policies, nor will it work to provide any advantage that is in violation of laws, regulations or deeds by the competent authorities or that which may expose Fiera Milano Foundation, Fiera Milano S.p.A., the companies controlled by them and the companies connected to them to sanctions, violation of prohibitions or restrictions established by resolutions of the UN Security Council or other applicable regulations concerning economic and commercial sanctions. Therefore, the Exhibitor subject to these restrictions will not have any insurance and indemnities as of now the Fiera Milano Foundation, Fiera Milano S.p.A., the subsidiaries and the companies connected to them from any and all liability for any harmful event it may suffer within the Exhibition Centres available/owned/managed by the aforementioned subjects, nor will it have any action, claim or request against the latter for the aforementioned events.

### 25. PHOTOS - VIDEOS

Subject to the terms specified in the last paragraph of this article, photos and videos by Exhibitors and visitors shall not be permitted inside the

halls, unless specifically authorized in writing by MADE eventi Srl. Exhibitors wishing to employ their own photographer may ask MADE eventi Srl for permission to take photos or record videos, but only inside their own stand.

MADE eventi Srl, if it deems it functional to the organization of the Show, reserves the right to take or have taken and use photos and video footage (overall or detailed) of the Fairgrounds, halls, exhibition areas and products on display without the Exhibitor having the right to claim compensation of any kind; in this regard, as better specified in the **Image Rights Release**, the Exhibitor assigns any and all rights necessary for the exploitation of such photographs and/or video footage.

## 26. ADVERTISING AND COMPETITIONS

Advertising material regarding exhibits is allowed only inside the Exhibitor's own exhibition area. Posters are allowed only inside the Exhibitor's own exhibition area. Unless duly authorized by and against payment to MADE eventi Srl, the following activities are also prohibited:

- **walking billboards, non-targeted distribution of leaflets, advertising material, etc., inside the halls, the Fairgrounds area, the external compounds at the entrance to the Fairgrounds area;**
- distribution of objects containing advertising messages;
- advertisement of shows, events, competitions and awards organized by companies, official bodies, organizations, newspapers, weekly magazines or trade magazines inside exhibition areas.

**The display of advertising posters inside the stand or invitations to visit displays outside the Fairgrounds or other exhibitions is strictly forbidden. The title of the Show cannot be used in product advertisements, promotional initiatives or events at venues other than the Fairgrounds unless expressly authorized by MADE eventi Srl.**

**In case of infringement of these rules, MADE eventi Srl reserves the right to enforce art. 34 of these General Rules and Regulations. In addition to the foregoing measures, if advertising materials or gadgets are found to be distributed inside the Fairgrounds or in the external compounds at the entrance to the Fairgrounds, the Exhibitor will be invited to immediately cease such activities.** In the event of non-compliance, a fine of € 5,000.00 + VAT (if due) will be imposed for every day of such unauthorized activity. Advertising other than inside the Exhibitor's own exhibition area may be allowed as permitted and exclusively managed by Fiera Milano S.p.A. or its partner companies, in accordance with MADE eventi Srl

## 27. SOUND BROADCASTING - SIAE (Italian royalties collection society) Sound broadcasting, amplification and advertising messages are prohibited.

**Audio-visual devices may be used provided that they do not cause disturbance to nearby stands or to the Show.**

Entertainment and performances may be staged in exhibition areas and common areas of the Fairgrounds only after 4.30 pm on Show days. The distribution of audiovisual and multimedia material containing works or part of works protected under Law no. 633 of 22.4.1941 shall be allowed subject to the prior payment of all copyright fees and the application of copyright stamps on all media in compliance with art. 181/bis of the aforesaid law.

**The unauthorized use of works and the lack of the SIAE stamp on the mentioned media are punishable by law, pursuant to art. 171 and onwards of Law 633/41.**

## 28. PROHIBITION OF PRODUCT SALES

**Retail sales are absolutely prohibited during the course of the Show, as are sales with immediate delivery of exhibited products (Reg. Law no.1 of 5/1/2000 - former Reg. Law no. 45/80, 2/V). Displaying product prices is also prohibited in any form and by any means whatsoever.** In the case of breaches, MADE eventi Srl reserves the right to immediately close down the exhibition area and exclude the Exhibitor from future Shows.

## 29. INTRODUCTION OF ANIMALS INTO THE FAIRGROUNDS

It is forbidden to bring any kind of animal into the Fairgrounds. This does not apply to animals which perform socially useful tasks, determined at the sole discretion of Fiera Milano S.p.A.. Guide dogs for the blind people, the canine units of the Police Force, the Armed Forces and the Civil Protection have free access, in the exercise of their functions and in compliance with the rules regarding their keeping.

## 30. FORCE MAJEURE

In the event that a cause of force majeure occurs, which has to be understood unpredictable events that make impossible the holding of the event and also for causes not attributable to MADE eventi Srl, the latter may: modify the date of the Exhibition and/or cancel the Exhibition, either entirely or in part. It is understood that in case MADE eventi modifies the date of the Exhibition, the Exhibitor continues to be involved by the commitment to participate to the Exhibition under the same terms and conditions as set out in these General Regulations and the application form for admission and the sums already paid by him will be considered valid for the new date. In case of the Exhibition is cancelled: MADE eventi Srl may use the sums paid by Exhibitors, with no obligation to refund the latter, to pay debts incurred with third parties, also for partial organization costs of any kind; and Exhibitors shall make no claims to MADE eventi Srl for damages or of any other kind.

## 31. AMENDMENTS TO THE GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

MADE eventi Srl reserves the right to amend, cancel or waive any of the rules and provisions included in the General Rules and Regulations as it shall consider appropriate for the proper conduct of the Show and the delivery of its services. Such rules and provisions are equivalent to these General Rules and Regulations and are therefore equally binding. They will be brought to the Exhibitors' attention on time.

## 32. PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING

**32.1** The Exhibitor declares to be informed that the provisions of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 - General Data Protection Regulation (hereinafter the "GDPR") concern the processing of data relating to natural persons ("Personal Data") and are not applicable to legal persons (companies), bodies and associations and information ("Information") relating to such parties, for which only the rules on sending commercial electronic communications remain unaffected (the Exhibitor may give the consent required for sending electronic communications for direct marketing purposes).

**32.2** Personal Data relating to the Exhibitor, where it operates as a sole proprietorship, small business or professional, as well as representatives, delegates, employees and collaborators of the Exhibitor indicated in the Application Form or disclosed even subsequently, as well as acquired from third parties (e.g. partners, commercial information companies, etc.) or within the scope of the Show (also, for example, any photos or video recordings at the stands: see art. 25 and 27) is collected and processed by MADE eventi Srl (hereinafter, the "Data controller") in the terms described in the following paragraphs.

**32.3** The aforementioned Personal Data is processed for the following purposes: to perform the obligations and services relating to participation in the Show (including the dissemination through the publication, also by electronic means, of the Show catalogues), to provide the relevant services, to fulfill the related regulatory requirements and to carry out the related administrative, accounting and tax activities. The processing of the Exhibitor's personal data is, therefore, necessary for the establishment and execution of the contract relating to participation in the Show, the fulfillment of the related legal obligations and the pursuit of the legitimate interests of our Company and the Companies of our Group to manage the administrative, organizational, technical and security activities related to the Exhibitor's participation in the Show and the provision of the related services. Failure to release, even partially, the personal data requested would not allow the Exhibitor to be admitted to the Show or to provide the related services.

**32.4** For these purposes, the personal data acquired in this way will also be processed by electronic means, with special procedures mainly computerized and suitable methods to ensure the proper management of the performance and services provided; it may be kept even after the Show for administrative, accounting and tax purposes for the time required by the reference regulations (generally ten years).

**32.5** For the above purposes, data may also be disclosed to employees and collaborators authorized by our Company to process data for the performance of the above administrative, technical and security activities connected with the organization and management of the Show and communicated to other companies in the Fiera Milano Group (see also the updated list available on the website <http://www.fieramilano.it/en>) and to companies we trust that provide us with organizational and technical services relating to the Show, such as, for example, stand fitters, service and maintenance companies, printers, data processing companies, administrative consultancy firms and companies measuring the performance of the Show. The companies that process personal data on behalf of MADE eventi Srl act as data processors, in compliance with the specific obligations set out in the relevant service contracts. For these purposes, personal data may be transferred to companies located in countries outside the EU (\*), if the European Commission has recognized that these countries have an adequate level of data protection (e.g.: Switzerland, Australia, Israel, USA for American companies signees of the agreement with the EU, so-called Privacy Shield), or based on appropriate warranties (such as standard contractual clauses or company rules binding on groups), or, in the absence of such conditions, if the transfer is authorized by the Exhibitor or necessary for the fulfillment of the contract with the same.

**32.6** The Personal Data (also in the form of images) concerning the economic activities (business or professional) of the Exhibitor may also be processed by the Data Controller, or by employees authorized by our company or companies responsible for processing, also for the pursuit of legitimate interests related to the analysis of information on the activity of the Exhibitor, participation in our exhibitions and in the required services; in particular, to identify, also through electronic processing, preferences and possible services of interest (so-called profiling), to measure the quality of services, to carry out statistical surveys in order to support decision-making processes and corporate strategies, to implement the design of corporate structures and, above all, to provide services and products that are functional to the needs of Exhibitors.

**32.7** The e-mail address and the address for paper mail provided by the Exhibitor for participation in the Show and the use of the relative services

may be used by the Data Processor to send the newsletter about the Show and the related activities of MADE eventi Srl, Fiera Milano S.p.A. and its Group as well as communications relating to events and similar services. The Exhibitor may at any time (immediately or subsequently) object to the sending of such communications by sending an objection message from his e-mail address to [privacy@madeexpo.it](mailto:privacy@madeexpo.it) or a postal communication to the Data processor, at the addresses indicated in the Application Form and Regulations.

**32.8** Without prejudice to the above activities of sending newsletters and communications relating to the Show and services of specific interest to the Exhibitor by e-mail or post, Personal Data and Information (e.g. telematic contact details) also referring to companies, bodies or associations may also be processed by the Data Controller with the prior consent of the Exhibitor (to be released through the appropriate boxes to be selected), for the following additional purposes:

- a) sending advertising material, direct sales, carrying out market research or commercial communications by post, telephone, automated calling systems, fax, e-mail, text messages, MMS, on further trade fairs, services and products of the Data Controller, Fiera Milano Group companies and third parties (organizers, Exhibitors, fitters, qualified operators involved in trade fairs or also operating in other sectors) interested in proposing advantageous commercial offers to Exhibitors;
- b) communication of data to Fiera Milano Group companies, (see also the updated list available on the website [www.fieramilano.it/en](http://www.fieramilano.it/en)), as well as other companies, such as organizers, Exhibitors, fitters, qualified operators involved in exhibitions or also operating in other sectors, such as market research institutes, sponsors and suppliers of Fiera Milano S.p.A. of independent processing, as data controllers, for the purposes and in the manner referred to in letter a) above.

**32.9** For the purposes referred to in the previous paragraph, the provision of Personal Data is, in any case, optional and has no impact on the Exhibitor's participation in the Show and on the use of the relevant services, and the natural person concerned has the right to revoke the consent(s) previously granted (without prejudice to the lawfulness of the processing based on the consent given before revocation).

**32.10** The provisions of the GDPR (Art. 15-22) guarantee the right of the natural person concerned to have access at any time to the data concerning it and to obtain a copy thereof, to rectify or supplement them if they are inaccurate or incomplete, to erase them or to obtain a restriction on their processing if the conditions are met, to object to their processing on grounds relating to the particular situation of the same person and, in any event, to their processing for direct marketing purposes, to request the portability of the data provided, where processed automatically for the execution of the contract or based on the consent of the person concerned, and to submit a complaint to the Privacy Protection Authority for the protection of its personal data and rights, if it believes that they have been violated.

**32.11** For any clarification or request regarding the processing of relevant personal data, the natural person concerned may contact the Data Controller at the addresses indicated in the Application Form and/or Regulations not only for asserting the rights mentioned above but also for knowing the updated list of categories of recipients of data and data processors possibly designated by our Company (also available on the website [www.madeexpo.it/en](http://www.madeexpo.it/en), privacy link). **32.12** The information referred to in this article is provided by the Data Controller under art. 13 of the GDPR and the Exhibitor undertakes to communicate it to the natural persons (its representatives, delegates, employees and collaborators) to whom the Personal Data supplied for participation in the Show and the provision of the relative services refer, as well as to guarantee that the Personal Data is lawfully usable by the Data Controller for such purposes and to indemnify and/or compensate the Controller for any cost or damage deriving from the breach by the Exhibitor of the obligations undertaken under this article towards the Data Controller.

(\* note for MADE eventi: if a transfer of Exhibitor data to non-EU countries is envisaged, before doing so one of the aforementioned conditions must be verified, implemented or documented.

## 33. USE OF IMAGES OF THE Exhibitor ACQUIRED DURING THE EVENT

In relation to the use of images of the Exhibitor acquired during the Event in relation to the images that concern the Exhibitor, the relevant exhibiting area and/or its representatives, members, employees and workers, acquired or recorded in any way (such as, by way of example, using cameras, video cameras or audiovisual recordings) during the Event, the abovementioned Exhibitor declares to be aware, pursuant to GDPR, that MADE eventi Srl and Fiera Milano S.p.A., may collect and process said images and that they may be disseminated for informative, promotional and commercial purposes pursuant to the terms specified in Article 32, to this end granting MADE eventi Srl and Fiera Milano

S.p.A. the free use with of these images, for these purposes, as per articles 96 and 97 of Italian Law no. 633/1941, authorizing MADE eventi Srl and Fiera Milano S.p.A. with no restrictions, and by engaging any means of communication (including therein, for example, brochures, presentations, catalogues and in general, all the paper material necessary for their disclosure and promotion, TV, pay-per-view, etc.) and dissemination via internet (company website, social networks, etc.) or via magazines and other publications, including digital ones, with the fullest rights to adapt and reproduce the same, for all legal purposes. For this purpose, the Exhibitor declares and guarantees to MADE eventi Srl that they have:

- (i) obtained the authorization of the data subjects for the processing of the data relative to their photos, video recordings etc. by MADE eventi Srl, including their dissemination for informative, promotional and advertising purposes pursuant to the terms of GDPR;
- (ii) obtained authorization for the use and dissemination of the images, pursuant to Articles 96 and 97 of Italian Law no. 633/1941 on copyright, in the above-mentioned terms, from the natural persons portrayed or recorded, their representatives, members, employees and workers during the above-mentioned event. In relation to the previous points (i) and (ii), the Exhibitor undertakes to indemnify and hold MADE eventi Srl harmless from all disputes, actions or claims that may be raised by the above-mentioned persons with regard to the indicated use and disclosure of the relative images described above.

### 34. BREACHES

In the event of failure to comply with the provisions of these General Rules and Regulations, MADE eventi Srl may, at their sole discretion and taking into account the seriousness of the event, sanction the Exhibitor by applying one or more of the following provisions:

- a) order the immediate removal of unauthorized products or remove them itself unless the Exhibitor complies immediately, and apply any additional sanctions;
- b) **order the immediate closure of the exhibition area or close it itself unless the Exhibitor complies immediately, and apply any additional sanctions;**
- c) order the Exhibitor to be banned from future editions of the Show. Exhibitors shall under no circumstances be entitled to claim refunds or damages of any nature and are obliged to pay MADE eventi Srl the full amount of participation fees envisaged by Art. 7 of these General Rules and Regulations. MADE eventi Srl may in any case request full compensation for damages suffered, including both emerging damage and loss of profit.

### 35. RIGHT OF RETENTION AND RECOURSE

MADE eventi Srl has the right to retain exhibited materials if Exhibitors should fail to meet their contractual obligations. Exhibitors shall pay all additional charges arising therefrom.

MADE eventi Srl is not liable in any way for damage to the displayed materials resulting from the exercise of said right. After the closure of the Show, the exhibition areas must be cleared at the latest by the time

that Fiera Milano S.p.A. will communicate. In case of failure to do so, just as Fiera Milano S.p.A. and MADE eventi Srl are not liable in any way for the goods and materials and other property deposited in the exhibition area, they also reserve the right to clear and store them, without any liability and at the expense, risk and danger of the defaulting party. Following two months, any property which has not been claimed may be sold at auction and any profit, net of the expenses and rights of MADE eventi Srl and of Fiera Milano S.p.A., will be credited to the Exhibitor. Storage of the Exhibitor's materials at the Fairgrounds will be subject to payment to Fiera Milano S.p.A. of the fee for the occupation of the area outside the period of the Show.

### 36. CLAIMS

All claims shall be submitted by the Exhibitor to MADE eventi Srl in writing.

### 37. COMPETENT COURT AND APPLICABLE LAW

Any disputes related or connected to the Application Form, the General Rules and Regulations or its Attachments which may arise between MADE eventi Srl and the Exhibitor shall be subject to the sole jurisdiction of the Court of Milan. The applicable law is the Italian law.

### 38. CHECKS ON COMPLIANCE WITH THE REGULATIONS

Without prejudice to the terms of the individual provisions, enforcement of the present Rules and Regulations is entrusted to the competent offices of MADE eventi Srl and Fiera Milano S.p.A. and any third parties (natural or legal persons) charged to do so by the same.
