WINDOW FRAMES CLOSE THE CIRCLE AT MADE EXPO 2017 AS A “WOODWORKING AREA” JOINS THE FAIR FOR THE FIRST TIME

After PVC and aluminium, wood completes the range of technologies available for window and door frame manufacturing. The “Woodworking Area”, coordinated by Acimall, makes MADE expo the only across-the-board benchmark for the building envelope sector.

For 2017, **Acimall**, the Italian Association of woodworking machinery makers, is hosting a space at MADE expo that adds **woodworking technologies** to the technologies for PVC and aluminium that already feature at the Exhibition. To make its showcase even more attractive, MADE expo has signed a multi-year deal with Cepra (the Confindustria association services company that among other things puts on the well-known Xylexpo exhibition) in order to include an area dedicated to wooden window frame technologies at the Fair.

Located within the MADE Building Envelope and Windows section, the “**Woodworking Area**” offers a chance to find out and learn more about window frames and construction, confirming MADE expo’s role as Italy’s only Fair that spans all of the different aspects of window-making technology. The addition of woodworking to the space MADE expo has always dedicated to machinery and installations is yet another strength for the upcoming show.

MADE Building Envelope and Windows attracted **more than 33,000 window and door-makers** in 2015, carving out for itself a position as Italy’s only event that represents the entire supply chain for windows and doors, blinds, shading systems, protection, the building envelope and coverings.
